## ANNEX I

The table below lists goods as classified in the Combined Nomenclature set out in Annex I to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87<sup>44</sup>, that are, referred to in Article 1 of the present Regulation.

The present Regulation shall not apply to goods if they are produced entirely from material that has completed its lifecycle and would otherwise have been discarded as waste, as defined in Article 3(1) of Directive 2008/98/EC<sup>45</sup>. This exemption does not apply to by-products of a manufacturing process, where that process involved material that was not waste as defined in Article 3 (1) of that Directive.

## ANNEX II

## Due diligence statement

Information to be contained in the due diligence statement in accordance with Article 4(2) of this Regulation:

- 1. Operator's name, address and, in case of relevant commodities and products entering or leaving the Union market, the Economic Operators Registration and Identification (EORI) number in accordance with Article 9 of Regulation (EU) No 952/2013;
- 2. Harmonised System code, free-text description, including the trade name as well as, where applicable, the full scientific name, and quantity<sup>46</sup> (expressed in net mass or, when applicable, volume, or number of units) of the relevant product that is intended to be placed on or exported from the Union market by the operator.
- 3. Country of production and geolocation of all plots of land where the relevant commodities were produced. Where the relevant product contains or has been made using commodities produced in different plots of land, the geolocation of all different plots of land shall be included in accordance with Article 9(1)(d);
